## General Information

### Arrival:

After dropping off your clubs at the bag drop, please park your car and go to the main entrance of the clubhouse for registration and breakfast.

### Registration:

### Locker Rooms:

### Practice Areas:

### Attire:

Men: All men must wear a collared shirt that must be tucked into either Bermuda length shorts or pants. No jeans or cutoffs of any kind are allowed. If you are wearing a cap it must be worn with visor forward. No jeans (denim of any kind) or cut-offs are permitted on the golf course.

Women: Proper golf attire is expected for women. All skirts, shorts, and dresses must be mid thigh length or longer. No jeans, cut-offs, or halter-tops of any kind are allowed. If you are wearing a cap it must be worn with the visor forward. Denim of any kind is not permitted on the golf course.

Guests using the Clubhouse may be casually dressed. Men are prohibited to wear hats in the Clubhouse at any time. Denim of any kind will not be permitted in the Clubhouse.
